Mumbai to get international business school

Industry stalwarts have together setup the Mumbai Business School (MBS). The institute has tied up with Pinnacle Education, in Knowledge City Dubai and Educatis University, Singapore to offer an integrated one-year post-graduate programme in management (PGPM). "Seventy percent of the faculty will be from B schools in the US," said Sunil Rai, CEO of MBS.

The B school will begin its operation from 2009. Industry specialisations in areas like media, wealth management, retail, insurance and manufacturing will be offered.

The school will accept XAT, CAT and GMAT scores for admissions and also conduct GD and PI. "We prefer students who have at least three to five years of work experience," said Rai.

The school will also offer a part time PGPM for working executives, a Phd programme in management for aspiring academicians and advanced certificate programmes in management.
